NACSW Convention 2018 – Student Frequently Asked Questions

When?

NACSW Convention 2018 will be held October 25 - 28 2018

Where?

NACSW Convention 2018 will be held in Hartford, Connecticut at the Sheraton Hartford Hotel at Bradley Airport, located at 1 Bradley International Airport, Windsor Locks, CT 06096

What?

The theme of NACSW Convention 2018 is: "Called to Serve Faithfully in a Rapidly Changing World: Loving Our Neighbors as Ourselves"

REGISTRATION

How do I sign up to be a student volunteer? You can print a form or register online to be a student volunteer at NACSW's Convention 2018 in Connecticut by going to the convention registration page. Submit your completed application and payment to NACSW online by October 5, 2018.

The registration rates for students are:

- \$110 Non-member Rate (includes 6-month NACSW membership at no additional cost)
- \$90 Member Rate (applies to current individual members of NACSW)

These registration rates include attendance to all convention workshop sessions, plenary sessions and banquet, but not preconvention institutes.

EXPECTATIONS
The success of the conference depends on volunteers!!!

What should I expect as a student volunteer? As a volunteer you can expect to spend some of your time (six to ten hours) at the convention providing assistance to help the conference run smoothly. You will be assigned tasks such as monitoring workshops, helping with set-up and take-down, or assisting with registration, etc. NACSW depends on its student volunteers to be responsible in fulfilling their volunteer assignments.

I just signed up as a student volunteer—now what? About two weeks before the convention you will receive an email from NACSW with a link to an online posting of your convention volunteer schedule and assignment(s).

How can I avoid a conflict if I am scheduled to volunteer at the same time I am presenting a workshop or poster session? If you are involved in presenting a workshop or poster session, please note that on your student volunteer application so that you are not scheduled to volunteer during that time.

ACCOMMODATIONS/PLANNING

Where can I stay? The conference is held at the Sheraton Hartford Hotel at Bradley Airport in CT. Hotel reservations can be completed online or through the toll-free number (800) 328-6242. Mention that you are affiliated with the North American Association of Christians in Social Work to receive the discounted rate. Room reservations must be made by October 3rd 2018 to guarantee the convention room rate of \$129 per night. Rooms are subject to availability. You may choose to share the \$129/night cost between up to three additional roommates if you know of other convention participants who are interested in rooming with you.

What should I bring? Dress at the conference is business casual. You may want to bring comfortable shoes for walking if you plan to take a side trip in Connecticut. You will need to bring spending money for your meals, and you may want to bring snacks and things to do in your downtime. The hotel provides complimentary internet access in the guest rooms.

Are meals provided? Dinner on Saturday evening is included in the convention registration, as is a light reception on Thursday evening and a continental breakfast break on Friday and Saturday morning. All other meals are on your own. There are restaurants in the hotel.

How much money should I bring? How much money you should bring depends on your eating and spending habits. Things such as dining in a hotel can be more expensive, but less expensive options will be available nearby. Also, remember to budget money for any excursions in Connecticut.

If I decide not to come, will I receive a refund? If requested, you will receive a full refund, minus a \$25 processing fee, through October 5th, 2018. No refunds can be offered after October 5^{th} 2018.
